How to Register

Red Cross courses taught in the Bakersfield area. After finding the course you want there are many different ways to register. You may register by phone and use your credit card, you may register at our office, or you may register online at www.KernRedCross.org. Our office is open Monday through Thursday from 8:00am to 5:00pm and Friday from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm. Make checks or money orders payable to American Red Cross. **Do not send cash.**

- * **Pre-registration is required for all classes!**
- * **You must attend all class sessions and pass all skills and written exams to receive appropriate certification**
- * **Please arrive for class on time. Students arriving after the start of class may need to reschedule (\$10 rescheduling fee)**
- * **Bring a snack and drink for classes over 4 hours**

Online Training

Our classes are available online at www.KernRedCross.org. You can complete the online lecture and schedule a skill session (listed below) to complete your certification – **It's THAT easy!**

Cancelling/Refund

If you do not show up for your class there are **NO REFUNDS**. Our staff will assist you in making the correct class selection but are not responsible for improper class selection; therefore, there will be no refund if you take the wrong class.

Rescheduling a Class

If for any reason you need to change the date of your class, a **\$10.00 rescheduling fee** will be charged if you do so **PRIOR** to your class. You may pay this fee and reschedule via mail, telephone (by credit cards), or by visiting our office.

Closed-Captioned

If you need a closed captioned monitor (or other equipment to meet special needs), please let us know ahead of time so we can make arrangements.

Group Training

If you have a group of 10 or more people, whether you are a business or a group of friends, we can bring the class to you! Group training allows a more flexible option for the same quality training offered at our chapter location.

Continuing Education Units

The American Red Cross has been approved as an Authorized Provider by the International Association for Continuing Education and Training (IACET). CEUs are offered as an add-on to training courses completed through the American Red Cross. Obtain Red Cross CEUs online at www.RedCross.org/store. Individuals are strongly encouraged to check with their specific regulatory boards, employers or other agencies to confirm that courses taken for IACET CEUs will be accepted by that entity.

Health Precautions

According to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), there has never been a reported case of any infectious disease transmitted through the use of CPR mannequins.

Red Cross follows widely accepted guidelines for the cleaning and decontamination of training mannequins. If you have a condition that would increase your risk or another participant's risk of exposure to infection, you will need to request your own mannequin prior to class. Request a separation mannequin if you have:

An acute condition, such as a cold or a sore throat, or open sores on your hands or around your mouth.

- * If you are currently infected with the Hepatitis B or C virus
- * Have any other type of infection or condition that would put you **or** those around you at increased risk for an infection.

If you decide you need your own mannequin, please call our 661-324-6427 ahead of time. **You will not be asked to explain the reason for your request. Training in CPR and First Aid requires physical activity.** If you have a condition that prevents you from taking part in the practice sessions, please let your instructor know.

First Aid Only

To give individuals in the workplace the knowledge and skills necessary to recognize and provide basic first aid care for injuries and sudden illnesses until advanced medical personnel arrive and take over. The course does not include information on breathing or cardiac emergencies. **Certificate upon successful completion: Standard First Aid (valid for 3yrs)**

This course combines a participant's manual, lectures and video with hands-on skills training to cover the following areas:

- Responding to breathing and cardiac emergencies in adults, children and infants
- Using an AED on adult and child victims of cardiac arrest
- Using personal protective equipment to stop bloodborne pathogens and other diseases from spreading

New Two-Year Certification!

Participants will receive the CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer and Healthcare Provider certificate with a validity period of two years. Lifeguards participating in this course will receive the CPR/AED for Lifeguards certificate valid for one year.
